John T. Lindsay Being first
duly sworn doth depose and say. That he
appeared in the Circuit Court of Pinne County
upon the trial of this cause for defendant
and upon the following circumstances when Mr H. O. Morris
attorney for plaintiff had this cause docketed in

the said Circuit Court for hearing. He informed
appellant that it was the wish and desire of
defendant that he appellant should appear
as attorney in said cause for defendant -
and further that it was the intention of said
Plaintiff to allow Judgment to go against
him in the Circuit Court for the purpose of
getting the cause in the Supreme Court at
its present Term, and said appellant being
employed as the attorney for defendant in
other causes in said Court, and being requested
by said defendant through Mr Morris
