State aforesaid

Be it remembered, that heretofore to-wit,
on the thirteenth day of May A. D. 1850, the following
proceedings were had in the Livingston County Circuit
Court, which which are in the words following, viz:

vs } Petition and summons
James Hunt & }
Hugh Cummins }

And now at this day came the parties
by their attorneys, and submits this cause to the court for trial -
After hearing the evidence in this cause, It is ordered, adjudged
and decreed by the court that the plaintiff a judgment against
the defendants for the sum of one hundred and seven dollars,
and his costs in this behalf expended, and that he have execution
therefor - And thereupon James Hunt, one of the
defendants in this suit by his attorney prays for an

Appeal to the Supreme Court. Whereupon it is ordered by the Court, that an appeal be allowed upon the defendant's entering into a bond of two hundred Dollars with security to be approved by the Clerk of this Court, as by agreement of parties, said bond to be executed and filed within thirty days.
