This was a suit for taxes brought in the Lee County circuit Court and judgement pronounced at the April Term 1848, against <sup>all</sup> the lands in the list mentioned. The suit is docketed "State of Illinois vs. Samuel M. Loggins & others" + suit for taxes. The record <sup>reflects</sup> that a return <sup>was made</sup> by the collector of Lee County, of certain tracts of land as having been assessed for taxes for the years in the return set forth, & that the taxes thereon remained due & unpaid on the 4th of April 1848, & that the respective owners had no goods & chattels whereon the collector could levy to satisfy the taxes, interest & costs due & unpaid on said lands.
