Now come the defendants by their attys Allw<sup>g</sup>  
Abbott and file an affidavit for an attachment  
against Joseph Sinclair, a witness for the defen-  
dants in this cause, and the Court upon examination  
of the said affidavit, orders, that the Clerk of this  
Court issue an attachment, and the said Joseph  
Sinclair being brought into Court, and being ex-  
amined on his oath, it is ordered by the Court  
that he be discharged; whereupon issue is joined  
on the third plea of the defendants, and ordered  
that a Jury be called, to wit: Frederick B. Miller,  
James T. Lucy, John Murphy, John C. Murray,  
Carrison Horne, Clement Bostonick William  
Maddox, Philip Best, Frederick Miller, Jacob  
Horne, Adam Erwald & Anton Petrovitch  
good and lawful men, who after being duly sworn  
and heard the testimony of witnesses and argument  
of counsel, retired to deliberate, and thereupon  
returned into Court, the following verdict:  
The the Jury find for the plaintiff the sum

of \$934.00 debt and the sum of \$142.43  
damages, it is therupon ordered by the court, that  
said plaintiff have and recover from the said  
defendants the said sum of \$934.00 for his debt  
and the further sum of \$142.43 for his  
damages, together with the costs by him expended  
in behalf of this suit and that execution issue  
~~to~~ whereupon the defendants by their said atty  
moved for a new trial, which was denied by the court, whereupon  
prayed for an appeal to the Supreme Court, which  
appeal is granted by the court, upon such defen-  
dants entering into bond in the sum of \$1500,  
within thirty days, with George Abbott & Joseph  
Lewis as their securities.

Whereupon the defendants on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of November  
A.D. 1858 filed the following appeal bond  
to wit:

I know all men by these presents that we  
Joseph B. Holmes, James P. Craig, George Abbott  
& Joseph Lewis of the State of Illinois one held  
and firmly bound unto Noah B. Garlow of  
Monroe County State aforesaid, in the sum  
of Fifteen hundred Dollars for the pay-  
ment of which full and truly to be made  
we bind our selves, our heirs, executors and admis-  
tators jointly by these presents,  
In witness whereof we have hereunto set our  
hands seals this twenty ninth day of November  
A.D. 1858,

The condition of the above bond is such  
that whereas the said Noah B Harlow died at  
the Special November Term of the Circuit Court, in  
and for the County of Monroe, State aforesaid  
received a judgment against the said Joseph B Holmes  
and James P Craig for the sum of \$1076<sup>4</sup>/<sub>3</sub>, debt  
and damages & costs of suit from which said  
judgment the said Holmes & Craig have prayed an  
appeal to the supreme court of the State of Illinois.  
Now if the aforesaid Joseph B Holmes and James  
P Craig shall truly prosecute the said appeal,  
and shall pay the said judgment and costs of suit  
and interest and damages in case said judgment  
shall be affirmed in said supreme Court upon the  
hearing of the appeal in said suit, then the aforesaid  
bond or obligations to be void otherwise remain in  
full force and effect.
