Now all men by these presents, that we
Asa Dudley and James Shaw & Capt. E. Kirine
and A. Watton Lewis Ellsworth, Securities,
all of the County of DuPage and State of Illinois,
are held and firmly bound to the People of
the State of Illinois, in the penal sum of five
thousand dollars, for the payment of which well
and truly to be made, we bind ourselves,
each of us, our heirs, executors and administrators,
firmly by these presents; signed with our hands
and sealed with our seals, dated at Naperville
in said County this 2nd day of June A.D.
1842

The condition of the above obligation
is such, that if the above bound Asa Dudley,
shall perform all the duties required to be
performed by him as Collector of the said County
of DuPage in the time and manner prescribed
by law, and when he shall be succeeded in office,
shall surrender and deliver over to his successor
in office all books, papers and moneys belonging
to said County or to the State, and ap-
pertaining to his said office, then the
above bond to be void, otherwise to remain
in full force
